A recent update from #AlAwda (24 July) said: "We have now sailed 5,000 nautical miles, from Bergen towards Gaza, with solidarity and medical supplies. The spirit on board is high.

It is hard to understand how our politicians can stay passive when we see all the great support from ordinary people, wanting to help other human beings. People who put human rights above political decisions.

Please help to put pressure on our elected representatives, put an end to the illegal Israeli blockade, and let the Freedom Flotilla pass through. Greetings from #AlAwda (The Return), 600 nautical miles from breaking the blockade."

Thank you for your support for the current or previous missions of the Freedom Flotilla Coalition.

As you probably know, three boats from the Freedom Flotilla Coalition's 'Just Future for Palestine' mission are currently on the Mediterranean Sea travelling to Gaza after having sailed for more than two months and having visited more than 20 European ports.

Five times, boats have successfully broken the blockade and reached Gaza (in 2008) and we maintain the hope that it can be done again with this Flotilla. The ever-increasing urgency on the ground in Gaza is finally getting the world's attention - hence we are also bringing medical supplies - and we are determined that this is the year the illegal blockade will finally be broken.

But to do this we need our amazing network of passionate people to amplify the work of this year's participants, crew and supporters in and out of ports that we have visited and passed through, as well as across the world.
